Erik Jensen, age 53, lifetime resident of Phoenixville, PA, passed away on June 10, 2020 at Bryn Mawr Hospital. He was the devoted father of Jessica and Lilly Jensen, and fiancée of Rose Barlow. Erik was the son of the late Paul and Wilhelmine (Binder) Jensen.

Erik was a graduate of Phoenixville High School. He attended Montgomery County Community College from 1999-2001, earning his Associates degree. Eric worked for Standard Register, and then was employed as an outside sales manager for the Mid-Atlantic region for Airline Hydraulics in Bensalem, PA.


