Marvin R. Stroman, age 88, husband of the late Nannette M. (O'Donnell) Stroman, of Royersford, PA, formerly a longtime resident of Phoenixville, PA, passed away on Saturday, April 24, 2021 in the Seasons Hospice, Phoenixville. Born on January 27, 1933 in Phoenixville, PA, he was a son of the late George and Eleanor (Gable) Stroman.

Mr. Stroman was a graduate of Phoenixville High School, and retired from American Inks and Coatings in Phoenixville after 30 years. He formerly had attended the First Presbyterian Church in Phoenixville. Mr. Stroman loved to work, often 2-3 jobs at a time, including post-retirement. Mr. Stroman also volunteered for St. Mary's Shelter in Phoenixville, and in his youth was a volunteer firefighter at Phoenix Hose, Hook, and Ladder Co. No. 1. A true supporter of anything Phoenixville, he attended as many Phoenixville football games as possible. He was also a member of the Phoenix Lodge #75, FandAM, where he served as the Worshipful Master three times and was instrumental in starting the Saturday dinners.

Mr. Stroman is survived by three children, David, husband of Audrey Stroman of Schwenksville, PA, Donna, wife of Roger Yashura of Douglassville, PA, and Denise, wife of Herb Jowett of Philadelphia, PA; four grandchildren, Sarah, wife of David Rasmussen, Sam Stroman, Tyler and Jared Yashura; one great-grandson, James Rasmussen; and one sister, Nancy Carl of Cleveland, GA. He was preceded in death by two siblings, Katherine Hughes and Margaret Eisenhauer.
