Ann C. Sanders, of Spring City, PA, wife of the late Norman M. Sanders, died Sunday, October 4, 2015 in Manatawny Manor, East Coventry Township, PA. Born on July 26, 1935 in Washington, North Carolina, she was a daughter of Thomas and Lucy Clemmons. She was educated in the Washington, NC school system. Mrs. Sanders received both a Bachelor's Degree in early childhood education and a Master's Equivalent from Southern Connecticut State University. She taught for 45 years cumulatively in Headstart and public schools of Ansonia, CT, New Haven, CT, and Baltimore, MD.
