Ann Williams Warner, aged 82, died peacefully at home on June 26, 2016, after a long and courageous struggle with both Hereditary Hemorrhagic Telangiectasia (HHT) and Congestive Heart Failure.

Ann was a remarkable woman who chose to live a joyful, gracious, and love filled life, despite many decades-long health challenges. Her joy filled and courageous approach to life will be missed by all who knew her.

Ann was born December 26, 1933, in Altoona, PA, the daughter of Ermatrude (Trudie) Hicks and Hubert Williams.
