She lived near New Brunswick NJ for 50 years before moving to South Coventry Township, PA to be near her family. Her zest for swimming made her a frequent sight at the Phoenixville Area YMCA and she was always proud of the miles she swam. She also enjoyed traveling and was able to visit five continents to appreciate all the world's beauty and enjoying life's moments, always with a smile. That endearing smile touched so many people and made her countless friends worldwide. We'd be remiss not to mention her wonderful Hungarian cooking and pastries, always a hit.
