Anthony L. Mungin Jr., age 74, husband of Alice C. (Fey) Mungin, of Royersford, PA, passed away on Friday, December 27, 2019 in Southeastern Veterans' Center, Spring City, PA. Born on March 8, 1945 in Phoenixville, PA, he was a son of the late Anthony Sr. and Kathryn (Yost) Mungin.

Mr. Mungin was a graduate of Spring-Ford High School, where he earned MVP while a member of the football team. Prior to serving in the United States Army during the Vietnam War, he attended Pierce Junior College. Mr. Mungin worked for Diamond Glass, first as a purchasing agent, and then for the credit union. He would go on to work for Superior Credit Union, and finally worked for the Spring-Ford School District as a janitor, a job he had a passion for. He enjoyed watching, coaching, and playing sports throughout his entire life. He was a Lower Perkiomen Youth Football coach, and also a baseball coach for the Spring-Ford Youth Athletic League. He enjoyed fishing and listening to many genres of music, including country music most recently. Above all else was family. From 1977-2001, he and his wife Alice were foster parents to over one hundred children, and during that time, had been named as "Foster Parents of the Year" for two consecutive years.
