



## Captain J. "Jack" Stusnick

February 26, 1926 - March 31, 2012

Captain John J. "Jack" Stusnick, age 86, husband of Margot A. (Morales) Stusnick and the late Margaret (Redick) Stusnick, died Saturday evening, March 31, 2012 in the Devon Senior Living Center, Devon, PA. Born in Edwardsville, PA, he was a son of the late John J. and Josephine (Dobkiewicz) Stusnick. He was a graduate of the Edwardsville High School and the Pennsylvania Maritime Academy. Captain Stusnick was a career naval officer, serving over 30 years in the Navy in engineering aboard numerous warships and aircraft carriers during the Viet Nam war years. He later served in various senior staff positions for the 1st, 3rd and 5th Naval Reserve districts. During his career, he earned many awards and commendations including the Meritorious Service Medal. He was a member of the St. Paul's Roman Catholic Church in East Norriton, and was a former member of the St. Joseph the Worker RC church in Fallsington, PA.
