June 8, 1924 - October 17, 2019

Catherine E. Buckwalter, age 95, wife of the late Paul L. Buckwalter, of Frederick, PA, passed away on Thursday, October 17, 2019 at Frederick Living. Born on June 8, 1924 in Franklin County, she was a daughter of the late David and Barbara Sollenberger.

Mrs. Buckwalter had served as a Deaconess at the New Life Bible Fellowship in Oley, where she was also a member of the senior circle known as "Forever Young". She also led Women's bible studies as well as taught Sunday School classes. She attended Winter term at Messiah College, and through those studies, she was introduced to her eventual husband, Paul. Along with him, she worked as secretary and they ran Paul L. Buckwalter and Sons Excavating, Inc. She was an active member of Gideons International, and enjoyed quilting and sewing.

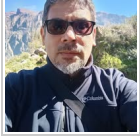
