Charles Owen (Chuck) Blue age 63 passed away Tuesday, February 2, 2010 at his home in Haverford, PA. Born July 15, 1946, Chuck was raised in Mechanicsburg, PA. He was a member of the class of 1964 at Mechanicsburg High School. He served in the Army in Germany, working as a Specialist 4 Laboratory Technician. After completing military service, he attended Temple University, where he graduated with a degree in Political Science.
