Charles L. Callen, age 68, husband of Helen C. (Parker) Callen, of Phoenixville, PA, formerly of Medford, MA, died Tuesday afternoon, April 9, 2013 in the Seasons Hospice at Phoenixville Hospital, Phoenixville, PA after a courageous battle with cancer. Born in Medford, MA, he was a son of the late Linus M. and Margaret E. (Clear) Callen. He was a 1962 graduate of the Malden Catholic High School, Malden, MA.
