Charles W. "Chas" Lawhorn, 43, of North Coventry, passed away unexpectedly in a motorcycle accident, on Wednesday, May 19, 2010, in Lititz. Born in Phoenixville, he was the son of the late Donald Lawhorn and Naomi (Dise) Lawhorn, of North Coventry. Chas was a 1984 graduate of Owen J. Roberts High School. Motorcycles were his passion as he was a member of the Reading Motorcycle Club (RMC) and the American Motorcycle Association (AMA) and was associated with many other local motorcycle clubs including Garden Spot Motorcycle Club, Pagoda Motorcycle Club and Blue Comets Motorcycle Club of Lansdale. In addition to his mother, he is survived by his sister Robin Lawhorn and her daughter, Cheyenne Theakston, of Narvon, his daughter, Jocelyne McNulty, of Pennsburg, his daughter's mother and dear friend, Amy McNulty, and her daughter, Alicia.
