Charles W. "Cheezy" Engle, age 71, husband of Marylouise E. (Dunyak) Engle of East Vincent, Pennsylvania, passed away on Tuesday, June 20, 2023 in the Paoli Hospital. Born on January 21, 1952, in Phoenixville, he was the son of the late Lillian M. (Siepmann) Engle and Charles D. Engle.

A Class of 1972 graduate of Spring-Ford High School, Charles began his employment at the age of 11 delivering newspapers before working at Allen's Variety in Royersford. He then was employed at B.F. Goodrich in Oaks, Nelson's Ice Cream in Royersford, Bentley Harris in Lionville and ultimately retired from Davlyn Manufacturing in Spring City in 2020.

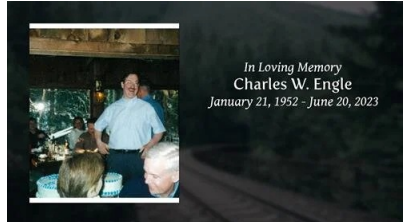
