Charles P. Hafner III, age 39, of Collegeville, PA, passed away on Wednesday, August 12, 2020. Born on December 26, 1980 in Phoenixville, PA, he was the son of Bridget A. Niemirovich, wife of the late Richard J. Martinelli Sr. of Collegeville, PA and the late Charles P. Hafner Jr.

Chuck was a kind, good-hearted soul with an infectious personality that others could not help but gravitate to. He excelled at all sports he participated in, including soccer, wrestling and football. At just 10 years of age, Chuck kicked a memorable 27-yard field goal during the last game of the season while playing with the Lower Providence Warriors midget football association. He earned his GED and worked throughout his life as a plumber, a trade he learned early in his life by working along with his stepfather, the late Richard J. Martinelli. In his free time, Chuck enjoyed spending time outdoors camping and fishing with friends and family, woodworking, listening to music and teaching himself to play the guitar.
