



## Charles Paul Michener

April 18, 1922 - April 11, 2020

Charles Paul Michener, age 97, husband of the late Anna Elizabeth (Hallman) Michener, with whom he shared 65 years of marriage, passed away on Saturday, April 11, 2020 in the Southeastern Veterans' Center, Spring City, PA. Born on April 18, 1922 in Heaverville, PA, he was the only son of the late Charles A. and Cora (Kershner) Michener.

Mr. Michener, known as "Paul", was a graduate of Upper Merion High School and served in the Army Air Corps during World War II in the Pacific Theatre.
