Christine 'Molly' Bowen (nee Kimes), 82, wife of Frederick A. Bowen of Kimberton, died peacefully in Phoenixville Hospital Friday, March 29, 2013, having been in failing health for some time. She was born in Phoenixville to Christine Clymer Kimes and Wilmer G. Kimes. Molly was a lifetime member of the First Presbyterian Church of Phoenixville, graduated from Phoenixville High School in 1948, and received a degree in education from West Chester Teacher College in 1952.
