Christine R. Milns, 97, widow of George L. Milns Sr., of Wyomissing, passed away on Monday, May 8, 2017 in The Highlands at Wyomissing. Originally from Camp Hill, she was the daughter of the late Eynon T. Rowland, Sr. and Mary M. (Snyder) Rowland.

Christine was a 1937 graduate of Camp Hill High School and received her B.S. degree in elementary education, specialized in kindergarten through third grade, from West Chester State Teachers College in 1941. She taught school in Dauphin, Berks, Chester and Montgomery counties. She had been a homemaker since 1970.

Christine had been a member of St. Peter U.C.C. Knauertown since 1942 and a member of the Dorcas Bible Class from 1942-1970. She and her family lived in Warwick Township, on the Milns Farm, from 1942-1955 and in North Coventry from 1958-1992, until she moved to The Highlands at Wyomissing.

Mrs. Milns is survived by her daughters: Mary Christine Milns and Ann Elizabeth Milns, of North Coventry. She was preceded in death by her son: George L. Milns, Jr.; and brother: Eynon T. Rowland, Jr.
