Claudia Althea Wilson, 91, formerly of Phoenixville, PA passed away on Monday, February 10, 2014 at Manatawny Manor. She was the widow of Granvil T. Wilson.

She was born in New York, NY to the late Vivian and Lillian (Van Putten) Richardson. She was a graduate of St. Phillip Nursing School, now part of Virginia Commonwealth University.
