Constance (Porte) Aigeldinger, 74, of Collegeville, passed away at Seasons Hospice of Phoenixville. She was the wife of Richard C. Aigeldinger, with whom she shared fifty-seven years of marriage.

She was born in Bryn Mawr, a daughter of the late Richard Jr. and Martha (Gaye) Porte. Mrs. Aigeldinger was a 1958 graduate of Conestoga High School, where she played Varsity Girls Basketball and wrote the Judy Column in the school newspaper.

Mrs. Aigeldinger was a member of Valley Forge Baptist Temple. A talented singer, Constance performed with the Conestoga Mainline Singers as well as many other local venues. She also did voiceover commercials for television and radio. Constance also wrote for the Able/Disabled column for the King of Prussia Courier newspaper.

She was a former MS Mother of the Year.
