



## Cortney Klumpp

May 1, 1976 - May 21, 2013

Cortney Klumpp, age 37, of Philadelphia, PA, formerly of Limerick, PA, died Tuesday morning, May 21, 2013 in the Harston Hall Rehabilitation Center, Flourtown, PA after a very lengthy illness. Born in Philadelphia, she was a daughter of Jack J. Klumpp, of Pottstown, PA and the late Mary Ruth (Mundt) Klumpp. She was a graduate of the St. Pius X High School in Pottstown and the University of Scranton.
