Dale William "Bill" Heltzel, age 82, husband of the late Janet I. (Arbaugh) Heltzel, of Pottstown, PA, formerly Union Bridge, MD passed away on Sunday, March 1, 2020. Born on March 12, 1937 in South Woodbury Township, Bedford County, PA, he was a son of the late Charles H. and Pauline E. (McInay) Heltzel.

Mr. Heltzel was a graduate of Franklin High School in Bedford County. Following high school, he volunteered for the Brethren Volunteer Service, being assigned to New Windsor, MD, where he would eventually meet his wife. Some of his early jobs included work in the steel mill, pumping gas, milking cows, working in a butcher shop, painting in the summers, and managing a feed mill. Following his time at the feed mill, he would go on to work for, and retire from, the finance department for the Maryland State Police. Mr. Heltzel was a member of the Pipe Creek Church of the Brethren in Union Bridge, MD, and attended the Coventry Church of the Brethren for the past 3 years while living in Pennsylvania.

A fixer and handyman, Mr. Heltzel loved repairing things, woodworking, and working around his shop and home. He enjoyed hunting when he was younger, and even recently enjoyed trout fishing in Pennsylvania. He enjoyed card games, among other various games, and found comfort in sewing quilts for the church. Following his retirement, he was involved with several

volunteer organizations, including Mothers Against Drunk Driving, SERVV International, and the Carroll County 4H Fair. He enjoyed attending yard sales, auctions, and visiting thrift stores.

Mr. Heltzel is survived by two children, Dennis W., husband of Nancy M. Heltzel of Pottstown, PA and Kay Ann, wife of Edward A.
