Dale A. Knapp Jr., 66, husband of Linda B. (Moyer) Knapp, of Phoenixville, passed away on Sunday, February 9, 2020 in the Phoenixville Hospital. Born on March 25, 1953 in Phoenixville, he was the son of Frances "Bette" (Fitzcharles) Knapp, of Royersford and the late Dale A. Knapp Sr.

Dale served in the United States Navy during the Vietnam War. He attained the rank of Petty Officer Third Class and was last stationed at Pearl Harbor.

Dale had most recently been employed as an installation technician for Office Environments in Cherry Hill.

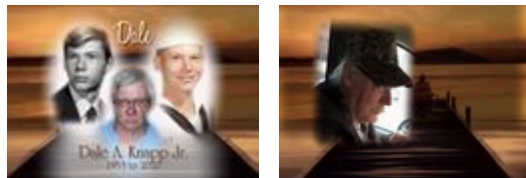
