Darwin O. Raysor, 94, of Pottstown, PA, passed away on Saturday, August 16, 2014 at the Southeastern Veterans Center, Spring City, PA. He was the husband of Opal J. (Hood) Raysor.

He was born in Linfield to the late Walter and Blanche (Schurr) Raysor.
