



## David "Ike" Eisenhower

April 12, 1945 - April 7, 2012

David D. "Ike" Eisenhower, age 66, of Royersford, PA died suddenly of natural causes on April 7, 2012 at home. Born in Royersford, he was a son of Ruth Cottrell of Royersford, and the late Elvin E. Eisenhower. Mr. Eisenhower was a graduate of Spring-Ford High School. He worked for many years for the American Baptist Churches in King of Prussia, retiring in January of 2012. He was a member of the Humane Fire Company for many years. He served as Fire Chief from 1981-82, 1989-93. Mr. Eisenhower was also a member of the Friendship Fire Company in Royersford. He worked as a bartender at Tom's Bar in Royersford for many years. In addition to his mother, Mr. Eisenhower is survived by three sons, Mark Eisenhower of Reading, PA, David K., husband of Brittney Y. (Cannady) Eisenhower of Royersford, and Shayne M. Eisenhower of Philadelphia; and one granddaughter. He was preceded in death by one sister, Peggy A. Hefelfinger.
