Dawn M. (Mowrer) Kulp, 78, wife of Harold R. Kulp, of East Coventry, passed away on Saturday, January 31, 2009, at her residence. Born in Pottstown and raised in Spring City, she was a daughter of the late B. Franklin and Helen Funk (Francis) Mowrer. Mrs. Kulp was a 1948 graduate of Spring City High School and also the Chester County School of Nursing where she graduated as a Register Nurse.
