Donald Michael White, age 75, husband of Suzanne Madeline (Scholl) White, of East Coventry, Pottstown, PA, passed away on Wednesday, March 8, 2017 at home. Born on July 9, 1941 in Kingston, PA, he was the son of the late Michael and Nellie (Furman) White.

Mr. White was one of Jehovah's Witnesses his entire life. God's Word was precious to him and at the forefront of his life. He was a faithful minister and elder in the Royersford Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses.
