Donna Marie Huppman, age 68, of Royersford, PA, passed away on Thursday, October 24, 2019 in the Paoli Hospital. Born on May 15, 1951 in Chester, PA, she was a daughter of the late Ralph and Catherine (Cunningham) Huppman.

Donna attended Our Lady of Charity School in Brookhaven, and graduated from Notre Dame High School in Moylan. She was a graduate of Harcum College, and received her Bachelors in Special Education from Millersville University. She retired from Vanguard. She volunteered her time with the Special Olympics and the Dave Thomas Foundation. Beyond all else, her family was the light of her life, and she cherished the time she spent with them all.

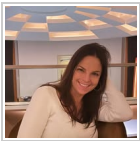
