Dorothy M. Frenier, 92, wife of the late Thomas W. Frenier, of Phoenixville, PA, passed away on Friday, August 14, 2015 in Parkhouse Nursing & Rehabilitation Center. Born in Philadelphia, she was a daughter of the late Walter and Marie (Guntz) Ritter.

Mrs. Frenier was a 1942 graduate of West Catholic Girl's High School in Philadelphia and had lived in France for a few years growing up. She was a member of St. Ann R.C. Church where she had been an active member of the Women's Guild. Dorothy had been employed as an insurance billing clerk for visiting nurses. She was a huge Penn State and all Philly sports fan. She was an avid reader, who always read the sports page first, then read start to finish. Dorothy was a pioneer woman and there was nothing she wouldn't attempt to try or fix. Her family was hugely important and close to her.

Mrs. Frenier is survived by her children, Michelle M., wife of Joe Costira of Douglassville, PA, Deborah F., wife of Joe Strogus of Phoenixville and Thomas J., husband of Connie Frenier of Hickory, NC; eight grandchildren; eight great-grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews. She was the last of her four siblings.
