



## Mr. Douglas D. Bowne

January 6, 1949 - November 21, 2022

Douglas D. Bowne, age 73, husband of Linda E. (Cooper) Bowne of Pottstown, PA, passed away on Monday, November 21, 2022. Born on January 6, 1949 in Staten Island, he was a son of the late Robert and Alice (Dawson) Bowne.

Mr. Bowne graduated high school in Staten Island, NY. He went on to further his education by attending Pinebrook Junior College, Fort Wayne Bible College, and the Presbyterian School of Christian Education, earning his Bachelor's degree. He retired after more than 30 years working as a production manager for the KenCrest Services Company in Pottstown. Most recently, he had been working as a transportation aide for TransNet in Pottstown.

Mr. Bowne accepted the Lord as his Savior at the age of nine while attending Victory Valley Camp in Zionsville, PA. Since 1970, he has been a faithful member of the Graterford Bible Fellowship Church, and served there in various ways through the years as an elder, Sunday School Superintendent, and worship team member. 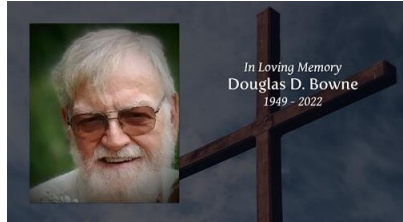
