Douglas A. Kandler, age 59, husband of Susan M. (Fasnacht) Kandler, of Morgantown, PA, passed away on Thursday, September 17, 2020 at home. Born on September 11, 1961 in Phoenixville, PA, he was a son of Joseph T. and Patricia A. (Miller) Kandler of Pottstown, PA.

Doug was a 1980 graduate of Owen J. Roberts High School, and graduated from the Philadelphia Institute with his certification as an HVAC technician. He was a lifelong member of Brownback's United Church of Christ, and was a descendent of the Brownback family. Doug and Susan shared 41 years of marriage, but if you would have asked him, he would have told you it felt more like 100. He was an avid hunter, and enjoyed his annual deer hunting trips with his nephews to Elk County. He enjoyed classic cars and wrestling. Doug worked in the preventative maintenance department at Lankenau Medical Center since 2008, and had previously worked for N.B. Barber Company in Uwchlan as a fire control inspector.
