Earl J. Sands, age 77, husband of Joyce A. (Miller) Sands, of Kimberton, passed away on Tuesday, October 25, 2016 in Parkhouse Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, Royersford. Born on June 26, 1939 in Norristown, he was the son of Earl and Dorothy (Beatty) Sands.

Mr. Sands was a graduate of Phoenixville High School. He owned EJ Sands HVAC for 18 years, then served as the Chief of Police for East Pikeland Township for 17 years until his 1992 retirement. He served as past President of the Chester County Police Chiefs Association and as past President of the Southeast Pennsylvania Police Chiefs Association in Philadelphia. Earl was active with KYAL as a former Coach and was a life member of the Kimberton Fire Co. An outdoorsman, he was an avid golfer and enjoyed hunting and fishing.

In addition to his wife of 59 years, Mr. Sands is survived by children, Earl J.
