Edward L. Reilley Sr., 80, husband of Darlene E. (Gilmore) Reilley, of Limerick, PA, passed away at home surrounded by his loving family on Tuesday, November 29, 2011. Born in Camden, NJ, he was a son of the late Samuel T. and Eva E. (Corn) Reilley. Mr. Reilley was a former King of Prussia resident for 50 years. He served in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean War. He worked as a warehouse supervisor at Thriftway Foods, a self-employed carpenter, and retired as a machinist from Alpha Tool. Mr. Reilley was best known for his humor and incredible memory. He enjoyed making people laugh, was an accomplished woodworker, recently mastered counted cross-stitch and loved spending time with his family, especially his grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
