Edward J. "Max" Maksimoski, age 77, husband of Maureen (McLaren) Maksimoski of Phoenixville, PA, passed away on Sunday, June 25, 2023 in the Phoenixville Hospital. Born on October 31, 1945 in Northampton, MA, he was a son of the late Edward and Victoria (Zanieski) Maksimoski.

Max was a graduate of Bishop O'Connell High School in Arlington, VA. He received his Bachelor's degree in Education from Villanova University in 1968, and he worked as a quality control manager for Devault Foods for 22 years. He was a faithful member of St. Ann Catholic Church in Phoenixville. Max honorably served aboard submarines in the United States Navy for 5 years.

As an avid reader and writer, he enthusiastically visited the Phoenixville Library daily, reading the newspapers and periodicals. Max was a self-proclaimed history buff and enjoyed learning about the civil war.
