Edward J. Pilcicki, age 72, husband of Mary A. (Hutchinson) Pilcicki, of Gilbertsville, PA, died Friday, January 13, 2017 after a very brief illness in Phoenixville Hospital. 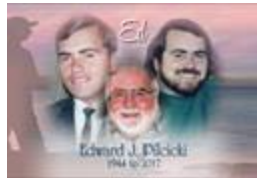
