Elizabeth A. (Rati) Wallace-Collins, 65, wife of Thomas Collins Jr., of Millsboro, DE, formerly of Phoenixville, passed away on Wednesday, June 30, 2010, in the St. Francis Hospital Wilmington, DE. Born in Philadelphia, she was the daughter of the late Andrew and Elizabeth Rati. Mrs. Wallace-Collins was formerly employed in Patient Information at Magellan in Great Valley. She was a member of Parkside United Church of Christ in Phoenixville, where she was very active in cooking and baking for events and the Dogwood Fair.
