



## Elsie L. (Scatchard) Reed

June 27, 1918 - May 8, 2014

Elsie L. (Scatchard) Reed, 95, wife of the late Roy K. Reed passed away on Thursday May 8, 2014, in Seasons Hospice, Phoenixville. Born in Norristown she was a daughter of the late Warren and Elsie (Shearer) Scatchard. She last resided at Spring Mill Assisted Living, Kimberton, PA.

During World War II she worked in an airplane defense plant, then later as a legal secretary to the District Attorney in Norristown. She was a founder and supporter of Ken Reed Auction Company which began by offering their auctions on the first floor of the town hall.

Elsie, also known as Mother, Nanny, and Redhead, touched the hearts of all who knew and loved her. Her appreciation for life, her wicked sense of humor, her delight in teasing, her compassion, and her love of her family will linger with all who crossed her path.
