Emily K. Hayes, age 25, cherished daughter of David C. and Kathleen (Harpp) Hayes, of Phoenixville, PA, formerly of North Coventry Township, died in the Albert Einstein Medical Center, Philadelphia, PA from injuries sustained in an automobile accident, on Sunday morning, February 3, 2008. Born in Phoenixville, she was a graduate of the Owen J. Roberts High School. She was very active with the band at Owen J. Roberts, serving as drum major her senior year. She then graduated from the Messiah College in Grantham, PA, with a nursing degree. She was working as a nurse on the fourth floor of the Phoenixville Hospital. Emily was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Phoenixville her entire life and was involved in children's programs, the youth group, the choir, and volunteered for two mission trips to Kentucky. She treasured her family time and especially enjoyed vacations spent with her extended family in the Adirondack Mountains each summer.
