Eugene E. "Gene" Byers, age 75, husband of Marie C. (Cathcart) Byers, of Phoenixville, PA, passed away on Friday, September 20, 2019 in the Parkhouse Nursing and Rehabilitation Center with his wife and son by his side. Born on September 6, 1944 in Bryn Mawr, PA, he was a son of the late Virginia (DePizzo) Byers.

Gene was a graduate of Haverford High School, and served in the United States Air Force during the Vietnam era. He worked as a firefighter and retired from the Warminster Naval Air Station.
