Eugene S. Kratz, husband of Jacqueline G. (Barth) Kratz, of East Pikeland Township, PA, died early Monday morning, February 23, 2009 in the Sanatoga Center, Lower Pottsgrove, PA, Born in Lansdale, PA, he was a son of the the Samuel B. and Margaret (Shellenberger) Kratz. Mr. Kratz was a 1952 graduate of the Norristown High School. A veteran, he served for the U.S. Navy and the U.S. Air Force. Mr. Kratz worked as a truck driver most of his life.
