Filomena Toussaint, 90, widow of the late Juan Guerrero, of Phoenixville, formerly Boston, MA, passed away on Thursday, October 2, 2008, in the Phoenixville Hospital. Born in the Dominican Republic, she was a daughter of the late Jedeon Toussaint and Felito de la Cruz.

Mrs. Toussaint taught second grade in the Dominican Republic. An Evangelist, Missionary, Counselor, and Minister, she co-founded The Good Samaritan Church of Christ in Puerto Rico, before co-founding a sister branch of the Church in the Dominican Republic. She was a former President of the Women's Ministries of the Assembly of God in Puerto Rico. After moving to Phoenixville, she co-founded The First Latin American Church of Christ, on Penn Street.
