The video is beautiful and such a nice tribute to her. We loved the family reunions and so glad to see a photo of that there.

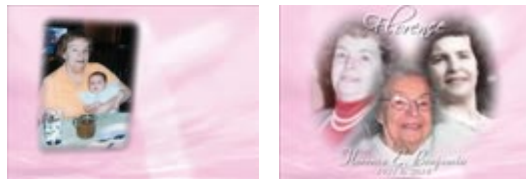
