



## Mr. Franklin R. Sellers

May 7, 1942 - May 1, 2022

Franklin R. Sellers, age 79, of Collegeville, PA, passed away at Einstein Medical Center of Philadelphia on Sunday, May 1, 2022. Born in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late John and Elizabeth (Bromley) Sellers. He was the loving husband of the late Gayle J.
