Gary A. Weary, 61, of New Hanover Twp, passed away on Sunday, January 22, 2012 at his home surrounded by his family after a courageous battle with brain cancer. He was the beloved husband of Becky (Gaus) Weary, who showed her a love she never knew existed. He was born in Muncy, PA a son of the late Daniel Weary and Gladys (O'Dell) Weary, of Montgomery, PA. He was a graduate of Montgomery High School and Lea College, of Albert Lea, MN. He earned a B.S. in Education and also played on the school's basketball team.
