Gary L. Hicks, age 61, of Spring City, PA, passed away on Saturday, July 11, 2020 at home. Born on September 4, 1958 in Phoenixville, PA, he was a son of the late Paul Jr. and Dorothy (Washington) Hicks.

Gary was a graduate of Phoenixville High School. He was first employed as a forklift operator for National Rolling Mills in Malvern, followed by Box King Products in Phoenixville. 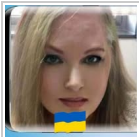
