George A. Behm Jr., husband of Mary (Tria) Behm, of Phoenixville, PA, passed away on Thursday, September 24, 2015 in Seasons Hospice, Phoenixville. Born in Winslow, NJ, he was a son of the late George A. Sr. and Mary (Colligan) Behm.

Mr. Behm served in the Navy during World War II. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Phoenixville since 1953. Mr. Behm graduated from Temple University with his Pharmacist degree. He was the owner of the Oaks Prescription Centre, was the director of the Pharmacy at the Phoenixville Hospital, Pennhurst Hospital, and retired as the director from the Pharmacy at the Norristown State Hospital. Mr. Behm was an avid fisherman and an accomplished saxophone player.
