



George A. "Sandy" Dunn, Jr.

July 5, 1942 - August 6, 2023

George A. "Sandy" Dunn, Jr., age 81, husband of Barbara M. (Prince) Dunn, of Chester Springs, PA, passed away on Sunday, August 6, 2023 at home. Born on July 5, 1942 in Bryn Mawr, PA, he was a son of the late George A. Sr. and Elizabeth (McIlreavy) Dunn.

Sandy was a graduate of Harriton High School. He went on to serve honorably in the United States Army, having been stationed in Germany during the Vietnam era. He retired after 45 years as a truck driver for McCandless Fuels.

Sandy spent his life surrounded by horses, hounds, and hunting friends as he strived every day to promote the sport of fox hunting. He served as the Master of Foxhounds (MFH) from 1978 until his passing, and as the huntsman for 35 years from 1978 until 2013. Along with his wife, he bred and raised the Penn-Marydel hounds used for the hunt at the family farm.

In addition to his wife of 47 years, Sandy is survived by his daughter, Barb Mueller; two grandchildren, Kiley and Hunter Mueller; two siblings, Betty Jane Dunn and David Dunn; and a nephew and a niece, Brad and Megan.

A private, commemorative hunt in memory of Sandy will be held. All are invited to attend an Irish Wake in celebration of Sandy's life on Saturday,
