



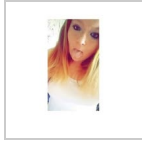
Gilbert Duncan

Gilbert L. "Butch" Duncan, 65, of Pottstown, PA died on Sunday, February 6, 2011 at Thomas Jefferson University Hospital. He was the husband of Linda (Deyoc) Duncan.
