

## Grant L. Rapp, Jr.

Grant L. Rapp, Jr., age 95, husband of the late Jeannette E. (Herr) Rapp, of Phoenixville, Pennsylvania, passed away on Thursday, May 21, 2020 in Seasons Hospice. Born on March 4, 1925 in Phoenixville, he was a son of the late Olivia (Grover) and Grant L. Rapp, Sr.

A 1943 graduate of Phoenixville High School, Grant served in the Merchant Marines during World War II. He had been employed for his entire career as a truck driver for several companies including Transcold Express, Yellow Freight and Lancer, a division of Jones Motors. 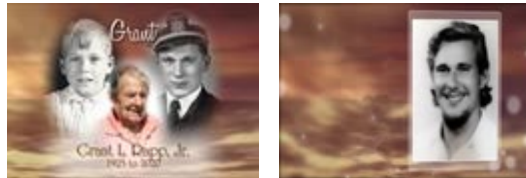
