Harry G. Getz, age 64, of Phoenixville, PA, died Monday, June 21, 2010, at his home. He was the husband of Lola D. (Dell'Arciprete) Getz. Born in Wilkes-Barre, PA, he is a son of Antoinette (nee Magarowicz) (Wilfred) Hoover, of Harrisburg and the late Harry Getz. Harry graduated from Phoenixville High School and also served during the Vietnam War in the U.S. Marines. He was employed as a Maintenance Mechanic at Wyeth, Collegeville, retiring in 2005. Harry was a member of the VFW in Phoenixville and enjoyed riding his Harley-Davidson Motorcycle with friends.
