Hayden Paul Mathias, 22, born in Novosibirsk, Siberia on July 18, 1998, passed away suddenly and unexpectedly on Thursday, August 27, 2020.

Hayden was an outstanding athlete who excelled in many sports but his passion for hockey was unrivaled. He played for many different hockey teams including the Jr. Flyers, Quakers, Minutemen, Valley Forge Colonials, Great Valley High School, and Bridgton Academy. Hockey was his life and he enjoyed every moment he was on the ice. But most of all, Hayden was a spirited and loving son, grandson, brother, cousin, nephew, teammate and dear friend to anyone who had the pleasure of knowing him. His colorful and often uncensored personality left an everlasting impression... and made for some of the funniest stories.
