Henry A. Arms, age 90, husband of Fay E. (Horner) Arms, of Royersford, PA died Monday evening, March 10, 2014 in the Phoenixville Hospital, Phoenixville, PA. Born in Stowe, PA, he was a son of the late John L., and Jenny (Bower) Arms. A US Army veteran, Mr. Arms served in the European Theater during World War II. He was a proud part of the invasion at Normandy. He received 3 purple hearts during his time served. Mr. Arms worked for many years at the Bethlehem Steel Plant in Pottstown, then worked for himself as a licensed plumber in the area.

In addition to his wife of 33 years, Mr. Arms is survived by two sons: Dennis N., husband of Christine Kuterbach, of Pottstown, PA; Henry L.
